

## Message from the President

December 2023

We have received confirmation that our FRIA application is in queue for review for Del Cerro Park. The list of applications is large and contributed to the delay in the start date for FRIA and remote identification requirements being enforced. The current date for enforcement is March 2024. We will see if that date holds. Once we have additional status on the Del Cerro application, we will communicate that information to you.

I had a family commitment that pulled me out of town last month. The trip required a road trip to Seattle. I managed to make good time and was running ahead of schedule and decided to make a side trip and visit the Evergreen Aviation and Space Museum in McMinnville, Oregon.

This is an impressive museum with two main galleries. One building is devoted to aviation, the other to space (with a few aviation displays here and

there). For those of you who follow Southern California's aviation history, you will know that this museum Del Cerro houses the Howard Hughes H-4 Hercules, better known as the Spruce

Goose. The museum covers the beginning of aircraft development to the present day with an amazing number of rare and beautifully restored and maintained aircraft (manned and unmanned) and space artifacts. I highly recommend you visit the museum if you are in the area. I have included a selection of the photographs I took at the museum. More details are available on their website.

Because I just can't seem to get enough of old aircraft, especially when they fly, I went out to Chino this past weekend for their monthly flight demonstration. This month they flew Mitsubishi A6M "Zero". This is the only aircraft of its kind flying in the world on the original Japanese

engine. This aircraft is fully restored and probably in better shape than when it was new. I have included a few static photographs of the aircraft.
