The City of Torrance had a community meeting last month to discuss issuing the lease for the field from which we fly at Entradero Park. Members of the community were asked to attend and voice their concerns. Although RC flying at Entradero was mentioned in passing, no opposition to our continued use of the facility was raised. The City

continues to voice their support for our continued use of the facility. The City will act as a coordinator for us negotiating a sub-lease with the baseball organization that

eventually takes over the field. Although no date has been announced, I believe the new lease for the baseball field will be in place by the end of February. I'll keep everyone posted as I hear more.

The City is emphatic that we lock the gates to Entradero Park. I know the gates are often open

when our members arrive at the field. We are being asked to lock them when we find them open and not leave them open when we are at the field. If the gates are open and non-PSF members are still present when we leave, we will need to leave the gates unlocked. The City knows that the gates being left unlocked is not solely a PSF issue. I told them we would do our part. The City also stated they would address our access to the North gate in the near future.




Club Is FAA Compliant


As you may know, both Entradero and Del Cerro Parks are within 5 miles of Torrance airport. John Spielman notified Torrance airport in November about PSF operations at the two fields, to ensure we are fully compliant with the "Special Rule for Model Aviation" in section 336 of the FAA Modernization and Reform Act of 2012. The notification states that we will keep our aircraft below 400 feet AGL.
