undergoing leveling and re-seeding. Once the field reopens, we will send a notice out to all of you. At that time, you will need to get in touch with a club officer to get the new field lock combination to access the field. Once the field opens, please let one of the club officers know if you have any access issues.

> As I mentioned above, weather has made flying at Del Cerro and the other local flying sites difficult. The parking situation is unchanged and requires using the app to reserve a parking space. If we get a weather window for

this Saturday, January 4th we will try to fly. The long range forecast is for cloudy skies and light winds of 8 mph out of the west-southwest. This should be flyable, depending on when the lift fills in. There is a 10% chance of rain in the morning. Hopefully a window develops allowing some flying. Guys usually show up between eleven and noon.
