## Message from the President

June 2021

The City of Torrance has not made any decisions regarding a date for allowing the use of the various community rooms. There are a lot of <u>AMA-scheduled events</u> in California this month. There are scale contests, IMAC aerobatic contests, the F5J contest I

If you are into aircraft larger than our guidelines allow at Entradero Park, there is flying taking place at UC Dominguez Hills. I have not made it over

For something completely different, the King Harbor Yacht Club RC Sailing group continues to hold practice races and the occasional contest at the club on Wednesday evenings. The majority of the guys are sailing Dragonflite 95 one-designs, but other boats are welcome. Folks start showing up between 4:00 and 4:30. Contact me if you want more details.
