

Message from the President

Unfortunately, we didn't hold a meeting this month. The start of June has turned out to be a busy period. We will re-convene in July.

We had an interesting meeting last month, with several of our member discussing their current projects and flying around the Peninsula and South Bay. It wouldn't be a PSF meeting if Bob Okita

didn't bring a plane or two to share. Last month Bob brought the plane featured in the video from the May newsletter, which has the Radian wing. As you could see in the video, the plane looks like a stable and fun platform. I've included a photo here.

Several of us have been flying small gliders at Avenue C in Redondo Beach, with our planes under the 10-ounce limit required by the City. I flew at Rocky Point for the first time in many months. Rocky is a great site when the wind is out of the

west. The site at PV East is down for awhile. Access is fenced off and goats are on the hillside taking care of the weeds. Of course, Del Cerro is a great option when winds are out of the southwest.

I have included a number of photos from my Planes of Fame visits in May and June. A number of aircraft were flown. Most notably, the Lions Museum displayed and flew their C-47. The Inland Empire chapter of the Commemorative Air Force flew their C-53. Both of these aircraft are D-Day veterans. They flew throughout Europe following D-Day. You could purchase rides on the C-53 following the flight demo. Pretty cool, as this year is the eightieth anniversary of D-Day.
