

Message from the President

March 2017

Please attend the meeting this coming Wednesday, March 1st. We will be discussing the Club response to a proposal presented by the baseball leaseholder for our continued use of the large field at Entradero Park. If you fly at Entradero, attend the meeting and share your opinions. It will be held at the community center at La Romeria Park, starting at 7:30pm.

Regarding Entradero, the ball is in our court. I have attended meetings with representatives of the City of Torrance and the new baseball leaseholder. In summary, the City wants PSF and the

leaseholder to come to an agreement and report back to them. The leaseholder is agreeable to our continued use of the field on a non-interference basis with their baseball activities. They have a sizable investment in the facility and would like PSF to contribute in some way to the field maintenance.

Our Club membership is currently down due to the lack of accessibility at Entradero and reduced

interest in glider flying at Del Cerro. Therefore, our ability to generate funds that would increase our support to Entradero field maintenance is reduced.
