These are sure crazy times! I hope all of you and your families and friends are well.

One positive effect from the stay-at-home order is that none of us has any reason not to finish any projects on the workbench. I know I will have a few new gliders ready to go, once the glider sites are open again.

Rancho Palos Verdes continues to keep the city parks closed, which means Del Cerro is unavailable for flying. There have been no definitive dates for re-opening them. On the bright side, the City has processed our RPV Del Cerro badges and John will pick them up when City Hall opens on May 18th. We will notify members when Del Cerro is again open for flying.

Rocky Point, which is a good flying site when the winds are westerly, and Bluff Cove are also currently unavailable for flying. The City of Palos Verdes Estates has closed all cliff access.

However, Entradero Park is still available for flying. The field gate combination has changed again. The Little League changed the Hallison Street Entrance (south side) lock and we currently do not have that combination. The baseball folks are reluctant to give it to us, since the gate has been repeatedly left open. The Tower Street Entrance (north side) lock is not changed. We are being requested to use the Tower entrance and ensure that the gate is locked after we enter and leave. Contact a club officer if you do not have the current combinations - and remember that only club officers can distribute the combinations to club members.

Baseball games at Entradero are suspended at this

time. There have been some small groups practicing on the little league fields. This activity is only occurring occasionally and usually on weekends. Please remember to keep the gates secured and protect the combinations.

Brian Johnson has rejoined the club and has been flying at Entradero weekday mornings.

Please practice the appropriate social distancing when flying at the field and

remember that it is up to every member to ensure our field rules are followed, which will protect our ability to continue using the facility.
