## Message from the President

November 2014

The facelift at Entradero Park continues. It appears that the grading has been completed. There are a number of open trenches around the park and the field we fly from. The pipe being installed appears to be for the grey water irrigation. Please be careful when moving around the trenches. They obviously present a hazard when accessing the field or recovering a plane. Avoid flying over any construction workers at the Park.

For those of you who have flown at 22nd Street in San Pedro, the site has been shut down. I have heard multiple stories why the site is no longer usable. I don't know which one is correct. I do know two things: 1) The police will tell you to leave the area if you attempt to fly there. 2) A number of the guys that used to fly there are showing up at Entradero.

If you are at the Park and non-PSF members are attempting to fly, introduce yourself as a club member, describe the club and invite them to join. If they have AMA, invite them to come over to the field and fly as a one-time guest. Also, inform them that City personnel will ask to see their PSF membership cards if they are flying at the Park. The City has stated that they are going to start asking to see our cards. Make sure you have yours with you.

In early October, Jerry Lake, Dave Haas, Joe Claire

and I made the Trek out to Prado. If you want to fly larger planes, this is the place to go. Large, wide open flying area, mountains as the back drop and the sweet smell of cow manure wafting in the breeze. What more could an RC pilot want? Electrics appeared to be in a slight majority bettering the gas models being flown. I have included a few photographs.
