

Message from the President

Progress has slowed at Entradero Park and we are still requested to stay off the field until hydroseeding is completed and the grass has taken hold. Some of our members have asked if we can fly over the now-nearly-dry settling pond. The short answer is no. The City is concerned about contaminants. The purpose of the settling pond is to act as first stage storm drain filtering. No one knows what the

chemical makeup of the soil is and we need to avoid walking on the dried soil.

That said, Brian Johnson (one of our members) had a very cordial and optimistic conversation with one of the

new baseball organizers who hold the lease to the field from which we fly. The baseball program very much wants us to continue using the field, as we will keep an eye on the facility for them. Additionally, flying from the field by our members does not impact the facility or cause additional work to upkeep the field, which alleviates any concerns on their part. Hydro-seeding is imminent based on

Brian's conversation. Assuming the grass grows well, the hope is baseball and our activities can resume on the field mid-to-late November. In the mean time, please refrain from flying or walking on

our field at Entradero. I have reached out to the baseball organization and will be meeting with them soon. As new details develop, I will keep you informed.

Obviously, there will not be a Fun-Fly at Entradero Park in the month of October. This month's Del Cerro Fun Fly will be held Saturday, October 8th. Guys usually start arriving between 12:00 and 1:00. Keep an eye on the weather. The current wind predictions are for west-northwest winds which may make the hill un-flyable.

Long time member and expert craftsman, Chet Schmidt, brought his latest project to the meeting for show-and-tell. Chet decided to build a kit this time, rather than scratch-building, with the intent of demonstrating how straightforward and satisfying it

is to build your own aircraft as opposed to buying an ARF.

The model Chet chose is a Sig Hog Bipe. Chet stated that the kit is of exceptional quality. The laser cut parts are self jigging

which results in the plane being built true without special tooling. As is typical of Chet's builds, he had to add a personal touch; the canopy appears to be from a P-51 Mustang. Chet highly recommends building this or another kit and experience the satisfaction of building and flying a plane you put together yourself. Chet brought the plane to the meeting without it being covered so the construction


of them are undergoing large-scale renovation and the contractor's employees are taking up many of the already-limited parking spots. Since most of these buildings are owned by the City of LA, the City must provide additional parking for the regular workers. They have decided to use the parking lot at FOD for this purpose. During the week, these cars occupy a large portion of the areas we used for parking, landing strip and pit activities. The number of cars has increased to the point where RC flying during the week is impaired, if not ill-advised, due to the possibility of hitting the cars with wayward aircraft. The SULA club has been told that the renovation work will continue until next spring.

We can still fly at FOD on Sunday and perhaps on Wednesdays and Fridays, if one can find a parking spot and is willing to fly off the relatively-rough grass. This more or less precludes all but lightweight planes like foamies or others without landing gear.

I have also heard that in return for allowing the cars to park at FOD, the contractor has agreed to fund the installation of light poles so that AYSO soccer teams can use the field after dark. These poles will likely ring the field and make flying considerably more difficult.
